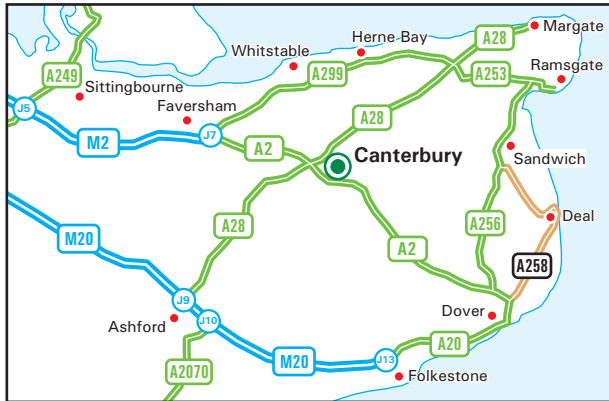

From the A2 London

- Leave the A2 at the first Canterbury exit and follow the A2050 towards Canterbury.
- Continue straight on at first roundabout adjacent to the Victoria Hotel.
- At the roundabout junction with the A290, turn right onto Rheims Way.
- At the next roundabout turn left onto Castle Street.
- Take the second left into Rosemary Lane and at the end follow the road round to the right into Stour Street.
- Take the 3rd right into Hawks Lane.
- The car park is the last entrance on the right.

From A2 Dover/Folkestone

- Leave the A2 at the first Canterbury exit and follow the A2050 (New Dover Road) until the roundabout junction with the A28 (cinema on left).
- Turn left at the roundabout. At the next roundabout (next to police station) turn right onto Watling Street.
- Continue straight over the mini roundabout.
- Carry straight on until you come to a T junction.
- Turn right into Stour Street and take the first right into Hawks Lane.
- The car park is the last entrance on the right.

Parking

- We have very limited parking which must be booked in advance.
- Public car parks are located on the inset map.
- There are three Park and Ride sites, at Wincheap, New Dover Road and Sturry Road (see map opposite).
- The buses currently run regularly between 7am and 8pm, Monday to Saturday, into the city centre.

By Train

- Canterbury has two stations and is served by trains from London Charing Cross and Victoria, Dover, Margate and Ashford International.
